Equipment and course familiarization:

- There will be contact equipment familiarization **SUNDAY MORNING ONLY**. Familiarization is **ONLY FOR THOSE THAT HAVE NEVER SEEN RUBBER CONTACTS BEFORE**.
- A warm – up area with a single practice jump will be provided for dogs entered in the trials.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Dog Show Rule books, Obedience Trial & Agility Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.00 (plus 5% GST) per copy.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show, which will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will also apply to these trials.
3. Entries will be acknowledged after entry closing, with receipt, judging schedule and exhibitor passes. If such acknowledgement is not received one week before the show date, please contact the Show Secretary.
Exhibitors Please Note: It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules pertaining to the event in which they are competing.

Move Ups between Trials 2 & 3 only- no same day move ups

We will try to accommodate those dogs with conflicts in conformation/obedience, but we cannot hold the rings.

Canada-U.S. Border Crossing: A valid rabies vaccination that has been given at least 30 days prior to entry into Canada is required to bring a dog into this country. Government regulations require a rabies vaccination certificate be provided for each dog.

Attention Foreign Exhibitors

Entry Payment: Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal cheques will be accepted; however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you pay by credit card, bankdraft, or money order payable in Canadian Funds.

Event Registration Numbers: All dogs that are foreign born and foreign owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC events do not require a CKC registration number but will require an Event Registration Number (ERN).

To obtain an ERN simply mail or fax a copy of the dog's registration certificate with a cheque money order or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature) in the amount of \$55.85 payable to the Canadian Kennel Club. This Event Registration Number MUST be applied for with 30 days of the first day of entering a CKC Event. General Information:

1. Bitches in Season are not permitted to compete. Entry fees will be refunded when a bitch comes into season after their entry has been submitted to the Trial Secretary, when a Veterinarian's certificate, certifying the bitch was in season within the 10 day period preceding the trial, is supplied to the Secretary on or before the start of the trial.
2. Only the dogs officially entered in these Agility Trials are permitted within the precincts of the trial.
3. Judging schedules, directions to site and receipts will be sent by email or by the post office to exhibitors after the closing date.
4. Before each trial the judges will provide a course design, which will be posted before judging begins. Courses will be different for all four trials

AGILITY CLASSES OFFERED

The following C.K.C. classes (divided by heights) will be offered:

REGULAR CLASSES

Standard Novice A: For persons and dogs that have never acquired an agility title in any country or organization.

Standard Novice B: For agility instructors and judges, and for dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice Title, but have not earned a qualifying score in Agility Intermediate; and for persons who have previously exhibited a dog to an agility title in any agility organization.

Standard Intermediate: Is open to dogs that have acquired the Agility Novice title, and to those dogs which have acquired the Agility Intermediate title but have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards the Agility Excellent Title.

Standard Excellent A: For dogs that have acquired the Agility Intermediate title, but have not yet earned the Agility Excellent title.

Standard Excellent B: For dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent title or the Agility Master Excellent title.

Jumpers with Weaves: same classes, heights, and conditions as for Standard Regular.

SELECTED CLASSES

The Selected Classes (both Standard & Jumpers With Weaves) follow the Agility Trials Rules & Regulations. The courses will be the same as in the Regular Classes but will have adjusted height and course times. Novice Select Class is not divided into A and B Divisions. The same rules apply for Excellent A & B as those described for the Regular Classes. A dog must be entered only in Selected Class or in Regular Classes at the same set of trials. They may move back and forth between the two Classes but not at the same set of trials offered by a club on the same day or on consecutive days.

Height Divisions - owners are responsible for entering the correct height divisions. The judge may require any dog to be measured.

REGULAR CLASSES: Standard & Jumpers with Weaves

- 8 inches - for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches - for dogs over 10 inches up to and including 14 inches at the withers
- 16 inches - for dogs over 14 inches up to and including 18 inches at the withers
- 20 inches - for dogs over 18 inches up to and including 22 inches at the withers
- 24 inches - for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

SELECTED CLASSES: Standard & Jumpers with Weaves

- 4 inches - for dogs 10 inches and under at the withers
- 8 inches - for dogs 14 inches and under at the withers
- 12 inches - for dogs 18 inches and under at the withers
- 16 inches - for dogs 22 inches and under at the withers
- 20 inches - for dogs over 22 inches at the withers

Exhibitor Information

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of and will comply with the CKC Agility Rules and Regulations. At the option of the handler, a dog may wear either a well-fitting plain buckle collar, a quick-release collar, or no collar. Fancy collars, choke collars, pinch collars, or other training collars are prohibited. Collars which are too tight or so large that they hang down unreasonable in front of the dog are not permitted. There shall be nothing hanging from the collar (12.3.1) Food and toys are not permitted in the course area and handlers are not permitted to use whistles or other training devices in the ring or within 10 feet of the course (12.1.1)

Agility Rules and Regulations: (4.1.3.t) It shall be the duty and obligation of the trial giving club to see that a judge, club official, volunteer, or any participant at an event held under these rules, is not subject to indignities of any kind. The Agility Trial Committee Chair shall promptly report to the CKC any infringement of this regulation, and the Discipline Committee shall have the authority to take such action as it deems fit, on receipt of a report indicating that this has occurred

Entry Requirements:

Every dog entered in a CKC approved Agility Trial must be purebred and must be registered with the CKC, or have an Event Registration Number, or be eligible for Registration with the CKC, or have a CKC miscellaneous Class Certification Number.

The dog must be at least 18 months of age, may be spayed or neutered. The dog may not be lame or compete if it has tape or bandages.

A dog may only be entered in one Standard Class & one Jumpers With Weaves Class at each trial.

Withdrawal of entries- If you wish to withdraw an entry prior to the close by email you MUST follow up the email with a phone call for confirmation of the withdrawal.
