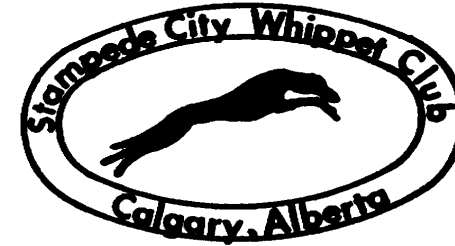

### ATTENTION ALL FOREIGN EXHIBITORS

Effective Jan/1992 all dogs that are foreign-born and foreign-owned and enter Canada for the sole purpose of entering CKC (Canadian Kennel Club) events will no longer require a CKC registration number but will require an ERN - Event Registration Number. This ERN does not register a dog with CKC for breeding purposes as defined in the Animal Pedigree Act but rather enables a foreign-owned dog to be awarded titles by the Canadian Kennel Club. Each dog must have its own number. To obtain an ERN, mail or fax a photocopy of the dog's foreign registration certificate with cheque or VISA/MasterCard number (expiry date, cardholder's name and signature). Provide your complete address for return of the ERN to you. **Cost is \$55.85 plus 5% GST.** ERN MUST BE APPLIED FOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF FIRST DAY OF ENTERING A CKC EVENT. All dogs must be entered in the regular classes, Veteran's class, "Specials Only", or for Exhibition Only to compete in the following non-regular and unofficial classes and Parade

**Brace** Two dogs of one breed (either sex or mixed) not necessarily owned by the same owner, shown on one lead by one handler.

**Stud Dog & Get** Stud Dog and two or more of his get, not necessarily owned by the same person.

**Brood Bitch & Progeny** Brood Bitch and two or more of her Progeny, not necessarily owned by the same owner.

**Working Class** For any dog having a championship in any of the following race disciplines: Canadian or American Lure coursing, Canadian or American Oval Racing, and American Straight Racing. Title must be noted on the entry form. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only.

**Maturity Class** 3 consecutive generations, not necessarily owned by the same owner. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only

**Parade of Veterans** For any dog (not necessarily a champion or titleholder) 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. Spayed or neutered dogs may be entered. Dogs must also be entered in a Regular class or for Exhibition Only. **Please supply a short biography with each entry.**

**Withdrawal of entries Please note:** An exhibitor has the right to withdraw an entry up to the closing date and time as published in the premium list. This may be done by telephone but written or electronic notification must be received by the Specialty Show Secretary no later than the official closing date and time. If written notification is not received by that time, the dog will remain entered in the show.

**GENERAL INFORMATION**

1. Dog Show Rule books and Obedience Trial regulations are available from the Canadian Kennel Club. Cost is \$6.00 plus 5% GST per copy.
2. The Show Superintendent will be in full charge of the show and it will be governed by CKC rules. All rules and regulations, as outlined in the Alberta Kennel Club premium list, will apply to this specialty.

Entries may be paid by Visa or MasterCard. Entries sent by Greyhound Bus must be prepaid for delivery and will not be picked up. Please do not send entries by Registered Mail. To comply with instructions issued by the Canadian Kennel Club, we will be unable to accept any entry reaching our Show Secretary after the closing time and date. **Please allow ample time for delays in the mail.**

**ATTENTION FOREIGN EXHIBITORS:** Please note that fees are due and payable in Canadian dollars. Due to consistently fluctuating currency rates, discounted cheques will not be accepted. Personal Cheques will be accepted, however, they are to be payable in Canadian funds. Please do not mark cheques "Payable in Canadian Funds" or "At Par". They will not be cleared by the banks. To simplify the process, we urge that you use our on-line entry and pay by credit cards or purchase bank drafts or money orders payable in Canadian funds. Your understanding and cooperation is appreciated. Thank you  
Tendering of an NSF cheque in payment of entry fees will be considered non-payment of entry fees and is an offence punishable by CKC disciplinary action and cancellation of awards. The owner of a dog entered in this show is entirely responsible for any error in the entering of his dog, regardless of how, or by whom the entry was made.

**Obedience Award:** The S.C.W.C. is pleased to award a prize & rosette to the Whippet achieving the highest qualifying score in the Alberta Kennel Club all-breed obedience trial on Saturday, August 1, 2009.

**Agility Award:** The S.C.W.C. is pleased to award a prize to the Whippet achieving the highest qualifying combined score in the Alberta Kennel Club all-breed agility trials #1 and #2 on Monday, August 3, 2009. In case of a tie, the prize will be awarded to the dog with the fastest combined qualifying time.

## **CLASSIFICATIONS**

The following CKC classes (divided by sex) will be provided:

Junior Puppy.....	for dogs 6 months of age but under 9 months of age
Senior Puppy.....	for dogs 9 months of age but under 12 months of age
12-18 Months.....	for dogs 12 months of age but under 18 months of age
Canadian Bred.....	for dogs born in Canada; champions in any country excluded
Bred By Exhibitor...	for dogs owned and handled in the ring by the breeder for this class, but need not handle the dog for further awards
Open.....	for all dogs.
Veteran.....	for any dog, 7 years of age or older on the day of the show. These dogs do not compete for Winners, but the winner of this class shall go on to compete for Best of Breed. <b>DOGS COMPETING IN THIS CLASS MAY BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED.</b>
Specials Only.....	for any dog who is a Canadian Champion. A CKC Registration or ERN must be indicated on the entry form at time of closing. The entry of a 'listed' dog in Specials Only is not allowed.
Exhibition Only.....	dogs entered in this class may not compete in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades if provided for in this premium list.
Exhibition Only ..... Puppies 3-6 Months	Puppies 3-6 months of age may be entered in Exhibition Only provided the Owner(s) has also entered an eligible dog in a Regular Class. These Puppies may not participate in any regular, non regular Classes or Parades
